### **CEI INSPECTOR/ENGINEER INTERN**

High school graduate or equivalent plus two (2) years of experience in construction inspection, which shall have been in bridge and/or roadway construction inspection on limited access toll roads. Or a Civil Engineering degree plus one (1) year experience in construction inspection, which shall have been in bridge and/or roadway construction inspection on limited access toll roads (Note: Engineer Intern classification requires E.I.T. certificate.)

Responsible for performing assignments in assisting Senior Inspector in the performance of their duties. Receive general supervision from the Senior Inspector who reviews work while in progress. Civil Engineering graduates must obtain certifications within the first six months of working as an Inspector or Engineer Intern. Exceptions will be permitted on a case-by-case basis so long as qualifications and certifications are appropriate for specific inspection duties.
